


DCV Portfolio increased 5,8%



The total investment portfolio on deposit with DCV is comprised 96,4% of instruments issued in dematerialized form, and 3,6% issued in physical form.

Investment portfolio deposited in DCV




Concerning the amount of the investment portfolio deposited with DCV corresponding to physical instruments, this totals UF 230 million (USD 11 billion), representing a 0.3 % decrease in relation to the previous month and a 9.4% decrease compared to November 2011.




UF transactions registered in DCV

The amount of transactions registered at DCV in November 2012 reached UF 3,169 million (151.2 thousand million dollars), which represents a 9.9% increase with respect to the amounts transacted and registered in the previous month, and a 16.6% decrease compared to November 2011.

The transactions registered in the January – November 2012 period amount to UF 33,996 million (1,622.5 thousand million dollars), which represents a 14,6% increase regarding the amounts transacted and registered at same period 2011.

The following graph shows the progress of the amounts registered in DCV systems in the period between November 2011 and November 2012.






In November 2012, the amount of stock market transactions (between brokers) is 16.2% (19.6% in 2011), whereas the amount of the transactions in the over-the-counter market (which includes transactions between investors and brokers) amounts to 83.8% (80.4% in 2011). Similarly, the amount of the transactions over instruments which originate from private debt and variable income instruments is 66.2% (58.9% in 2011) and that of public debt, 33.8% (41.1%

In the January - November 2012 period, the amount of stock market transactions (between brokers) is 17.4% (20.9% in 2011), whereas the over-the-counter market (which includes transactions between investors and brokers) amounts to 82.4% (79% in 2011).

Similarly, the amount of the transactions over instruments which originate from private debt and variable income instruments is 67.1% (60,5% in 2011), and that of public debt, 32.9% (39,5% in 2011).


The highest transaction volumes in the december 2011 and November 2012 periods were performed over the following instruments.



The number of transactions registered in DCV in November 2012 amounts to 136,681, balance which represents a 10.2% decrease compared to the previous month and a 2.8% decrease compared to same month 2011.

The total accrued in the January - November 2012 period amounts to 1,511,818 transactions, which represents a 4.7% increase with regard to the number of transactions registered in same period 2011.

The following graph shows the progress of the number of transactions registered in DCV systems between November 2011 and November 2012:






In November 2012, the number of stock market transactions (between brokers) is 24,9% (26.1% in 2011), whereas over-the-counter market transactions (including transactions between investors and brokers) amount to 75,1% (73.9% in 2011). Similarly, the number of transactions over instruments originating from private debt and variable income instruments is 93.7% (88% in 2011) and public debt transactions, 6.3% (12% in 2011).

In the January - November 2012 period, the number of stock market transactions (between brokers) is 23.9% (26.2% in 2011), whereas over-the-counter market (including transactions between investors and brokers) amounts to 76.1% (73.8% in 2011). Similarly, the number of transactions over instruments originating from private debt and variable income instruments is 7.5% (99% in 2011) and public debt transactions, 7.5% (9.9% in 2011).

The highest number of transactions in the periods December 2011 and October 2012 were performed over the following instruments.
