



Total portfolio deposited with DCV increase by 1.9%

The total balance of the investment portfolio on deposit with DCV at the close of October 2015 totals UF 7,124 million, equivalent to USD 263 billion. This represents a 1.9% increase relative to the previous month's balance and a 5.1% increase in relation to October 2014. This total amount in custody is comprised 99.5% by local custody (98.7% by securities position accounts, and 1.3% by BRAA accounts) and 0.5% by international custody.

The total investment portfolio deposited in the DCV consists in 96.3% of instruments issued in dematerialized form and by 3.7% in fitness.

Composition of the local custody

The investment portfolio deposited in the corresponding DCV local instruments, UF reached 7,091 million (261.8 billion dollars) at the end of October 2015, representing an increase of 1.9% from the previous month and a increase of 5% compared to October 2014.

The total of the local custody is comprised of the balance in position accounts equivalent to UF 7,001 million, in addition to UF 90 million in Active Affiliates Recognition Bonds (BRAA) maintained in inventory accounts.

Composition of the National Holdings October 2015






Composition of the International Custody

The volume of the international custody amounted to UF 33.7 million (USD 1,243 million) at the close of October 2015, representing a 4,2% increase relative to the previous month, and an 45.5% increase in relation to October 2015.


The total of the international custody is comprised of the international custody balance equivalent to UF 28.8 million, in addition to UF 4,9 million, corresponding to the balance of the securities in custody traded in the foreign securities exchange (BE).

Composition of the international Holding October 2015






UF transactions registered DCV

The volume of transactions registered with DCV in October 2015 amounted to UF 3,513.8 million (USD 126.7 billion), which represents a 6.1% decrease relative to the volume traded and registered the previous month, and a 8% increase compared to October 2014.


The following graph shows the progression of the amounts registered in DCV systems during the period between October 2014, and October 2015.




UF transactions registered in DCV

UF -Transactions October 2014 Instruments








Number of transactions recorded in the DCV


The number of transactions registered in DCV in October amounted to 134.277 a balance that represents a 1.5% decrease relative to the previous month, and a 12.7% decrease compared to the same month 2014.

The following chart shows the progression of the number of transactions registered in DCV systems between October 2014 and October 2015.





Amount of TX - instruments October 2014








Transactions registered in DCV – Forward Service

Contract subscriptions - Type of CLP - UF Forward operations

The amount of CLP – UF Forward operations registered in DCV at October 2015 amounted to UF 66 million, which represents a 3.1% decrease relative to the amounts registered during the previous month.

Subscription contracts - Exchange Operations in million CLP-UF


Subscriptions Contract - Forward Exchange operations CLP - USD

Record number of contracts
